



Toot, toot! Here comes the tunnel!

Shout out the name of each engine.




Draw puffs of steam for Thomas.





"Prepare to blast off!" peeped Thomas.




But when the engines got to Knapford Station, the rocket was in pieces.

"The rocket fell apart!" gasped Percy.




Gordon chuckled. "No, no. It's just too big to deliver in one piece," he said. "You will all have to take it to Brendam Docks in small pieces."

Kana took the booster. "That's what makes it go, go, go!"






Diesel took the wings. "Now it can fly!"

What part could Thomas deliver?


All that was left was a tiny battery.
