Before reading

- Ask your child: What are the girls in the picture doing? What might happen in the story?


During reading


- . If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: 1-o-ck, lock.
- · If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.

After reading


- Ask your child: Where did the girls find the map showing where the den was? (in the box)
- · Has your child played in a den? Talk about it.




