Before reading

- · Ask your child: Who do you think Jess is? (the cat) What might happen in this story?


During reading


- · If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: J-e-ss, Jess.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about the story.

After reading

- Ask your child: Why do you think Jack gave Jess a hug at the end of the story?
- Talk about some of the good (and less good) things about having a pet.









