# Help your child to read!

This book practises these letters and letter sounds.  
Point and say the sounds with your child:

qu sh th nk

Your child may need help to read these common tricky words:

I and to go be is no

## Before reading

- Look at the cover picture and read the title together. Read the back cover blurb aloud to your child.
- Explain that in this story, a girl collects lots of things to make a picture.

## During reading

- If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: th-i-ck, thick.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about the story.

## After reading

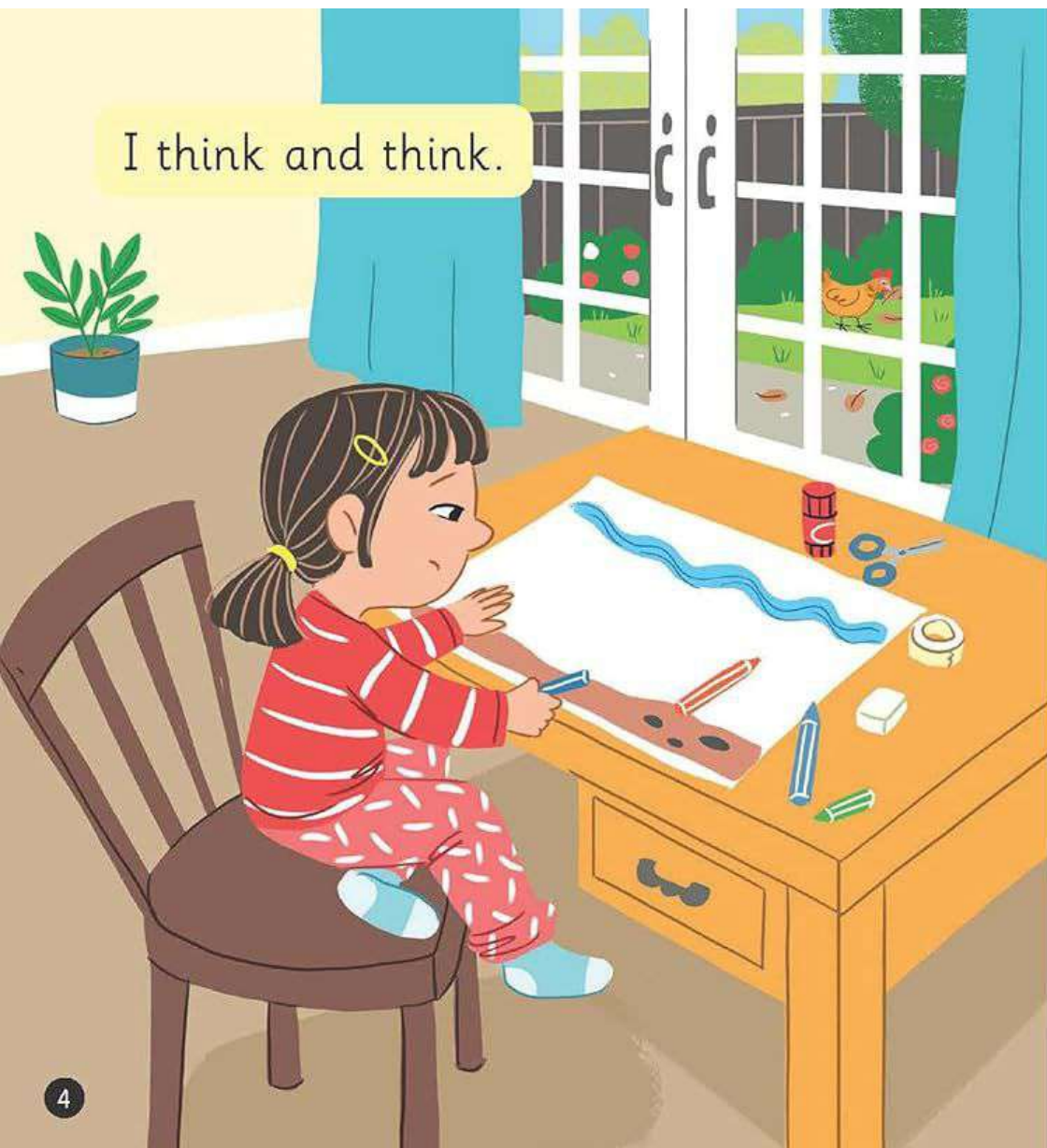
- Ask your child: Can you remember all the things the girl collected for her picture?
- Talk about your child's ideas for things they could collect to make a picture. Maybe they could make their own collage picture!

Can you spot the chicken on 7 pages?

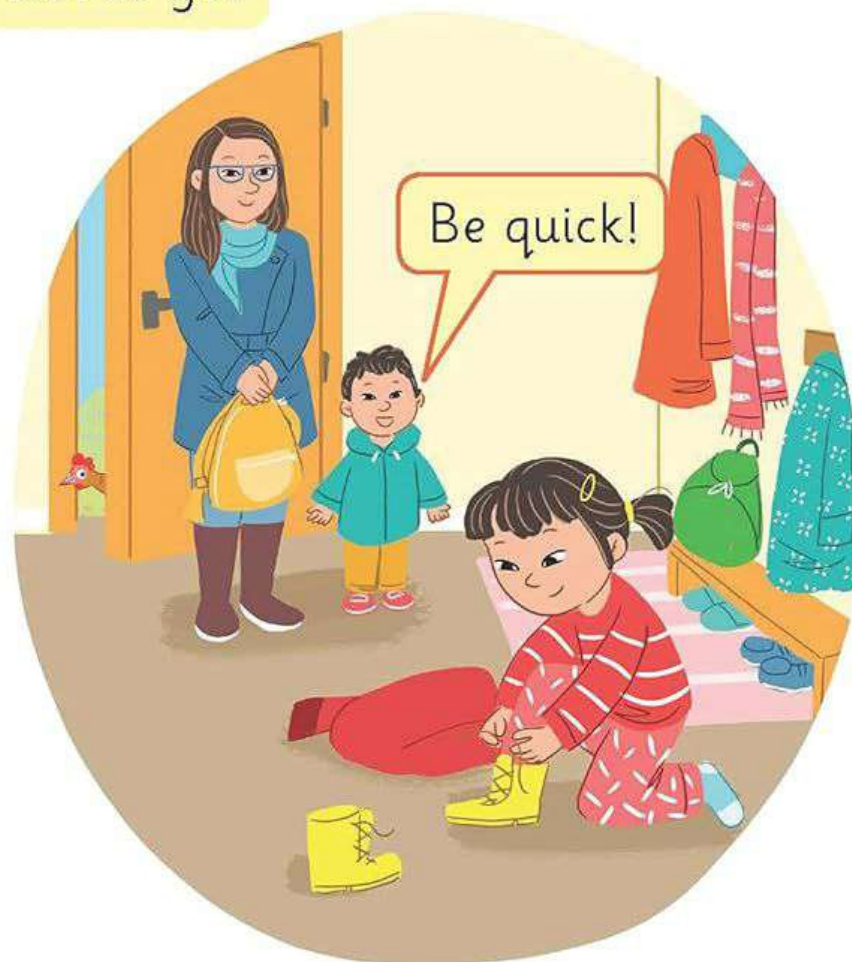

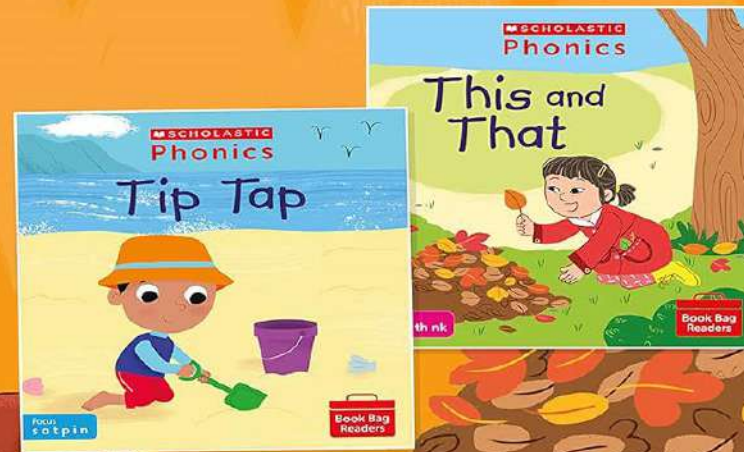

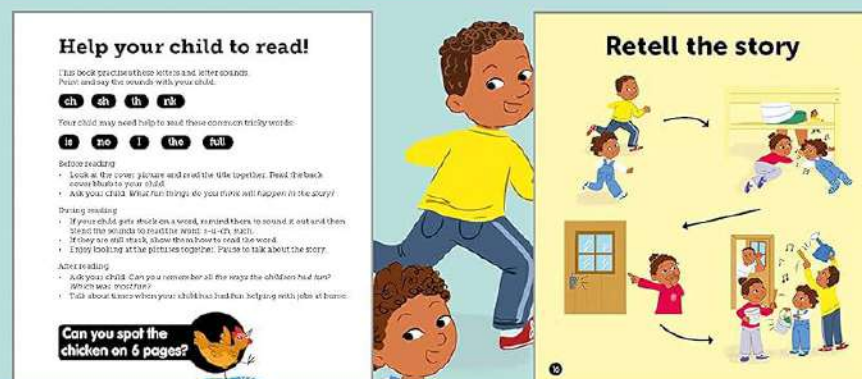
