Before reading

- Look at the cover picture and read the title together. Read the back cover blurb to your child.
- Ask your child: *Have you ever been on a boat? What was it like?*

During reading

- If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: r-ee-f, reef.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about the story.

After reading

- Ask your child: *Have you ever seen any sea creatures at the beach?*
Can you describe them?

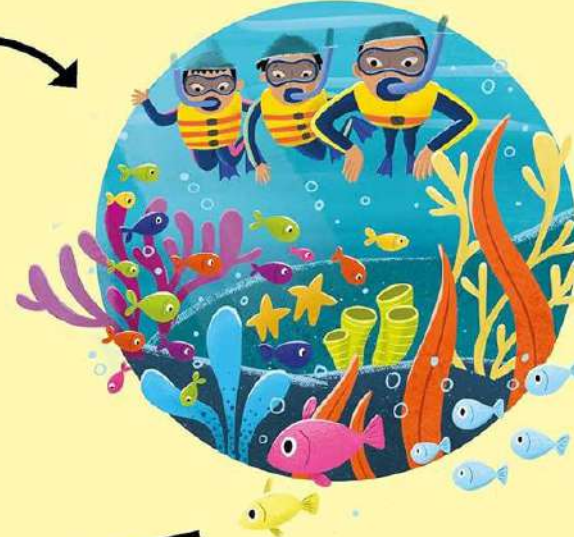
