### Before reading

- Look at the cover picture and read the title together. Read the back cover blurb to your child.
- Ask your child: Have you ever played a funny trick on anyone?
  What happened?

#### During reading

- If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: h-oo-t-s, hoots.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about the story.


## After reading
