# Help your child to read!

This book practises these letters and letter sounds.  
Point and say the sounds with your child:

ee igh oo (as in 'look') oo (as in 'food')

Your child may need help to read these common tricky words:

we put and go the are full of I  
into they to be

#### Before reading

- Look at the cover picture and read the title together. Read the back cover blurb to your child.
- Ask your child: *Do you remember being outside at night? What did you do?*

#### During reading

- If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: f-oo-d, food.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about the story.

#### After reading

- Ask your child: *What food would you like to eat from a food van?*
- *Have you ever seen an animal at night?*

We get a big bag of food.

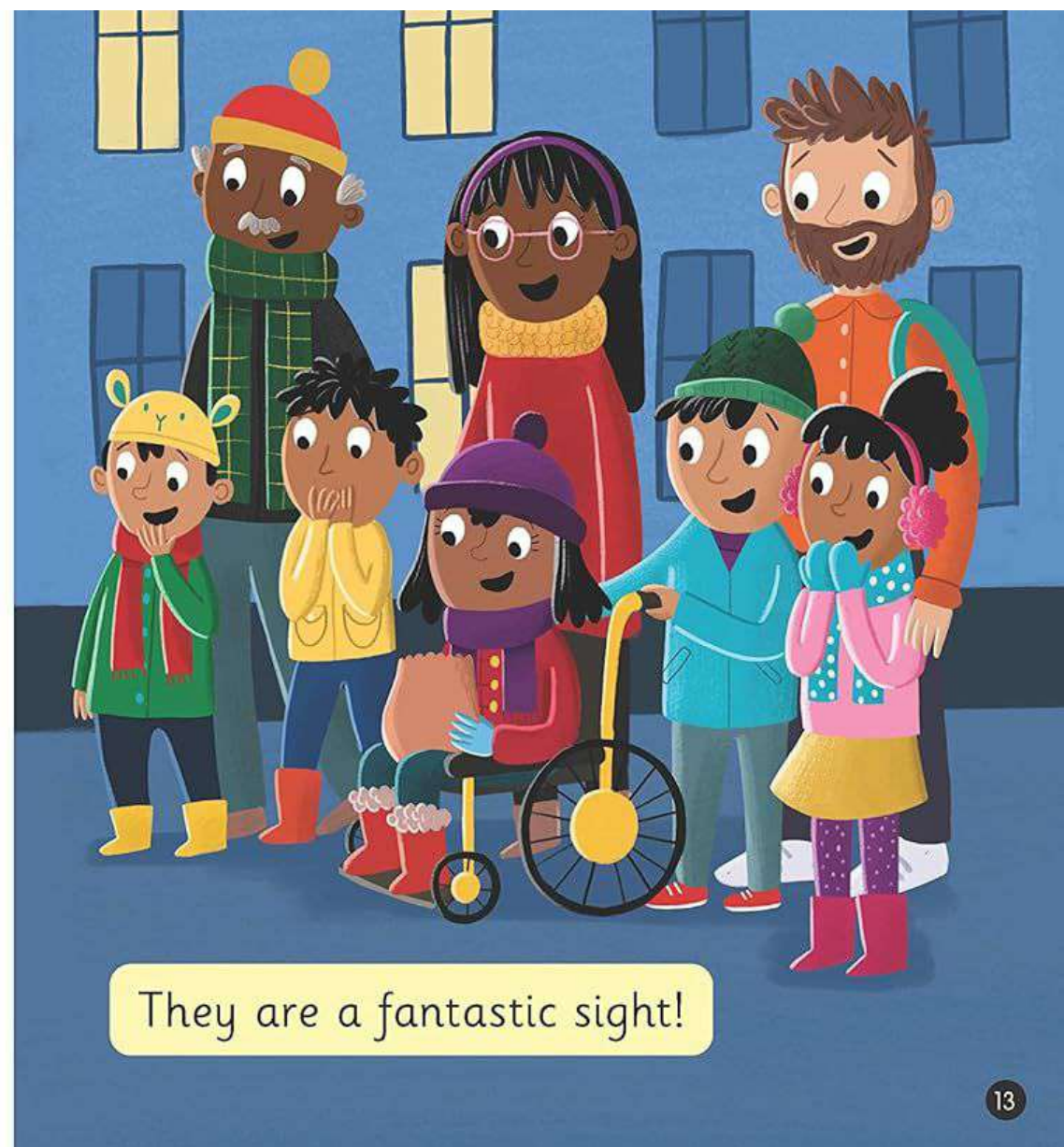

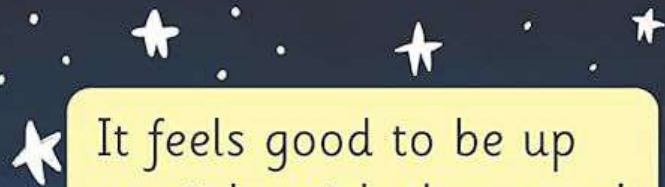
