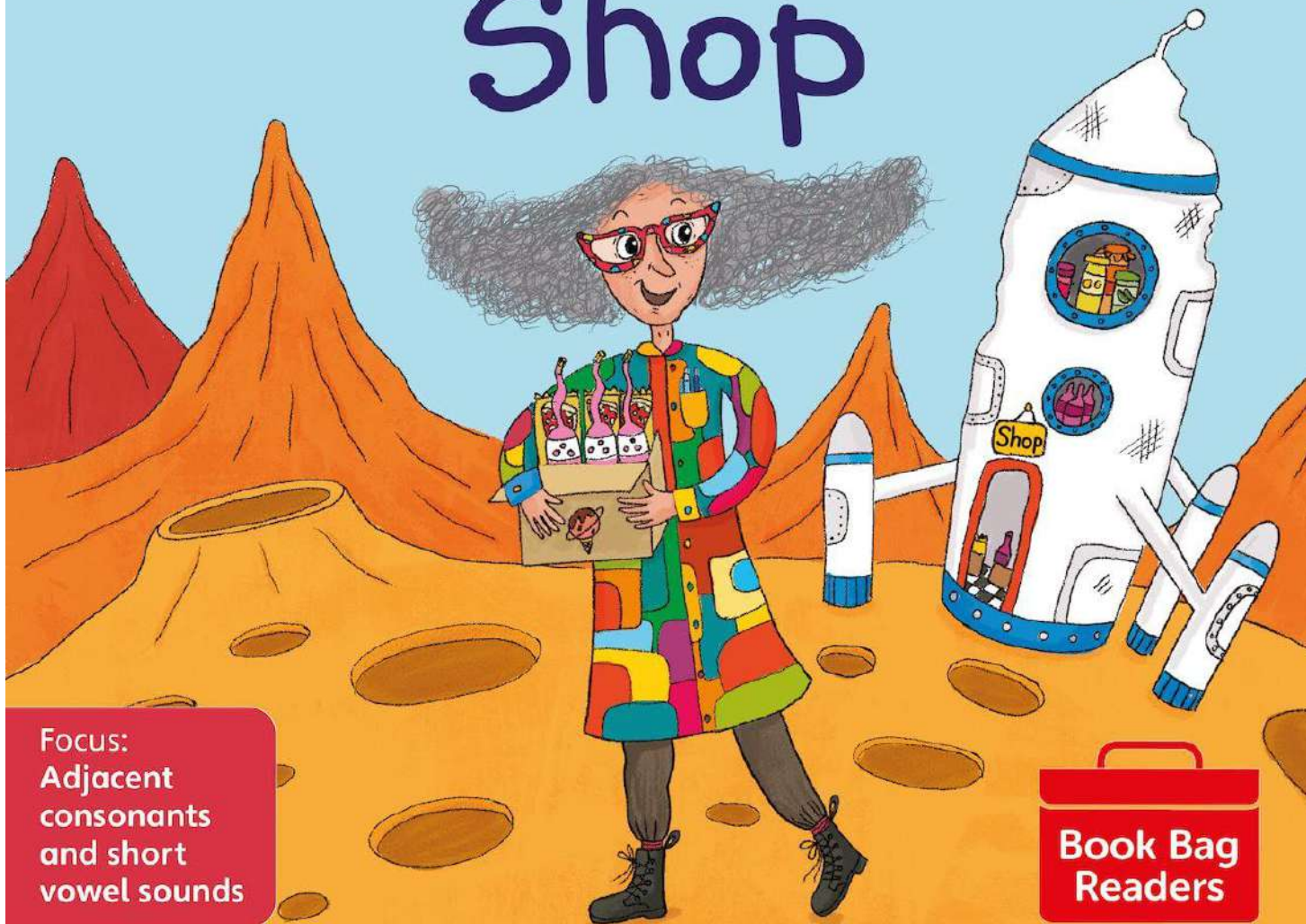

Help your child to read!

This book practises words with more than one consonant next to each other, plus short vowel sounds (like 'crash' or 'left').

Before reading

- Look at the cover picture and read the title together. Read the back cover blurb to your child.
- Ask your child: *Where do you think this story is set? What kind of vehicle is the travelling shop?*

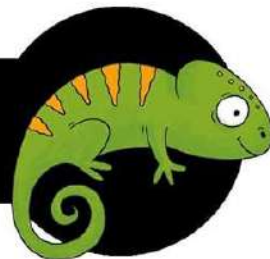
During reading

- If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: p-l-a-n-e-t, planet.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about the story.

After reading

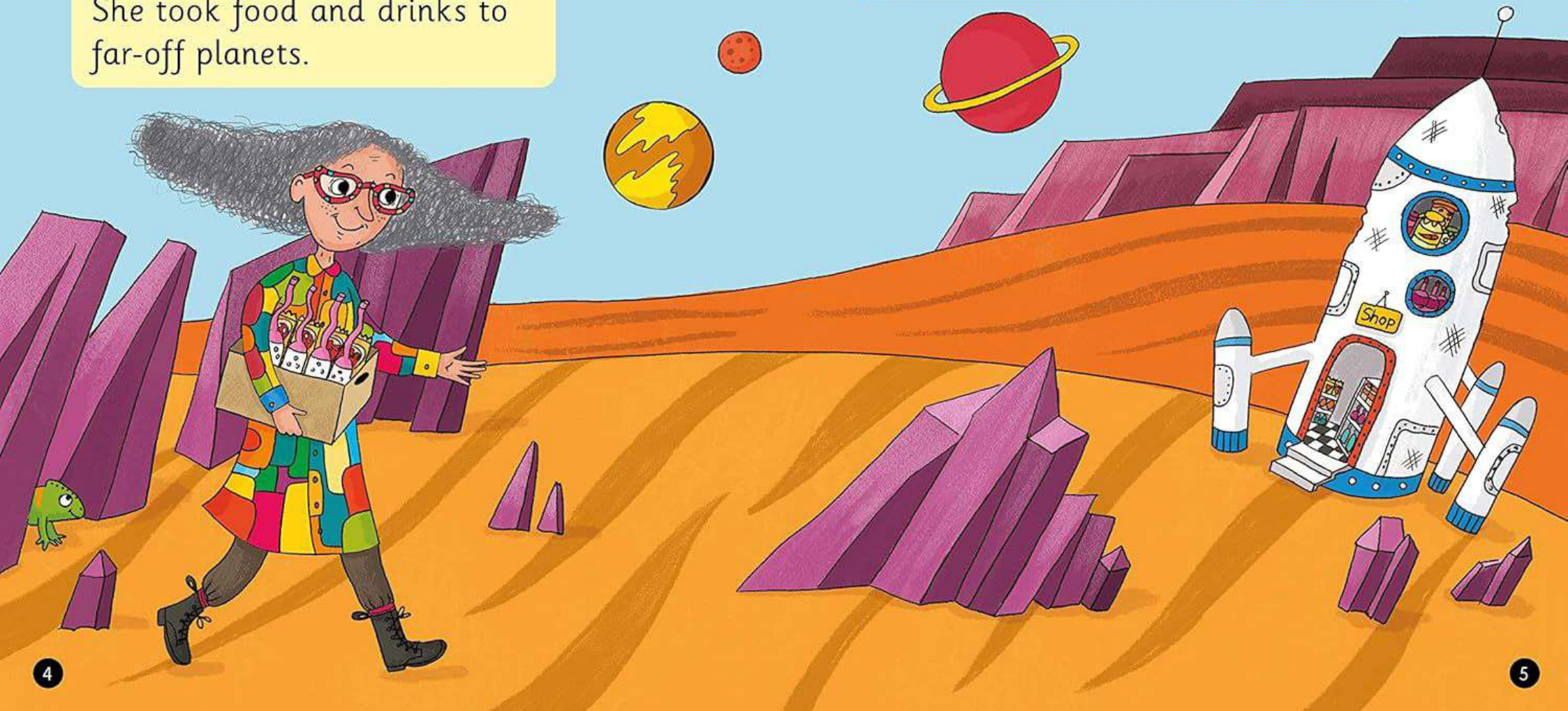
- Ask your child: *How do you think Mildred felt when she heard the footsteps? Why?*
- *How did Mildred say thank you to the aliens who helped her?*

chameleon on 6 pages?

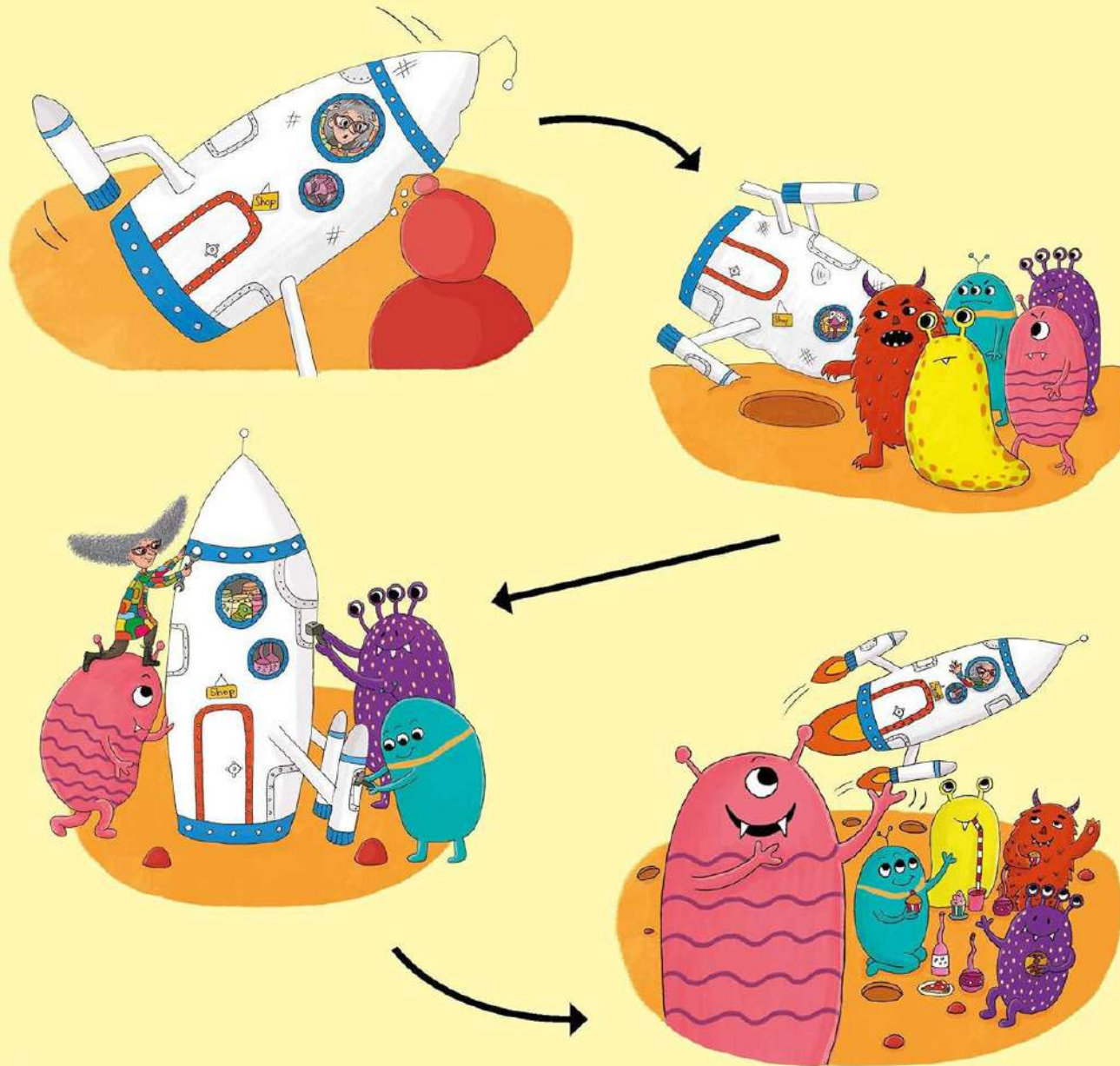


Mildred had a travelling shop.
