


Help your child to read!

This book practises words with more than one consonant next to each other, plus long vowel sounds (like '**br**ight' or '**agr**ee').

Your child may need help to read these common tricky words:



Before reading

- Look at the cover picture and read the title together. Read the back cover blurb to your child.
- · Ask your child: Have you ever been to the fair? What did you like most about it?


During reading


- If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: s-p-ee-d, speed.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about the story.

After reading


- Ask your child: Do you think Dad loved the fair at the end of the story? Why?
- Which ride in the story would you go on?
