Before reading


- Look at the cover picture and read the title together. Read the back cover blurb to your child.
- Ask your child: Do you know what these animals are called? (elephants) What do you know about elephants?


During reading

- If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: n-i-p, nip.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about them.

After reading

- Talk about the image on page 8. What can your child tell you about it?
- Ask your child: Can you remember what the elephants did in this book?
- Discuss which page your child liked best, and why.
