Before reading


- Look at the cover picture and read the title together.
 Read the back cover blurb to your child.
- Ask your child: Do you have a pet dog? Do you see many dogs near your home?
- · Talk about the image in the magnifying glass.

During reading

- If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: d-o-g, dog.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about the information.

Afterreading

- Talk about the images on page 16. What can your child tell you about them?
- Ask your child: Why was the girl asleep at the end? Was the dog sleepy too?
- · Talk with your child about which activity they think looks the most fun.
