Before reading

- Look at the cover picture and read the title together. Read the back cover blurb to your child.
- Ask your child: *Do you like making things? Have you ever made a puppet?*
- Talk about the image in the magnifying glass.



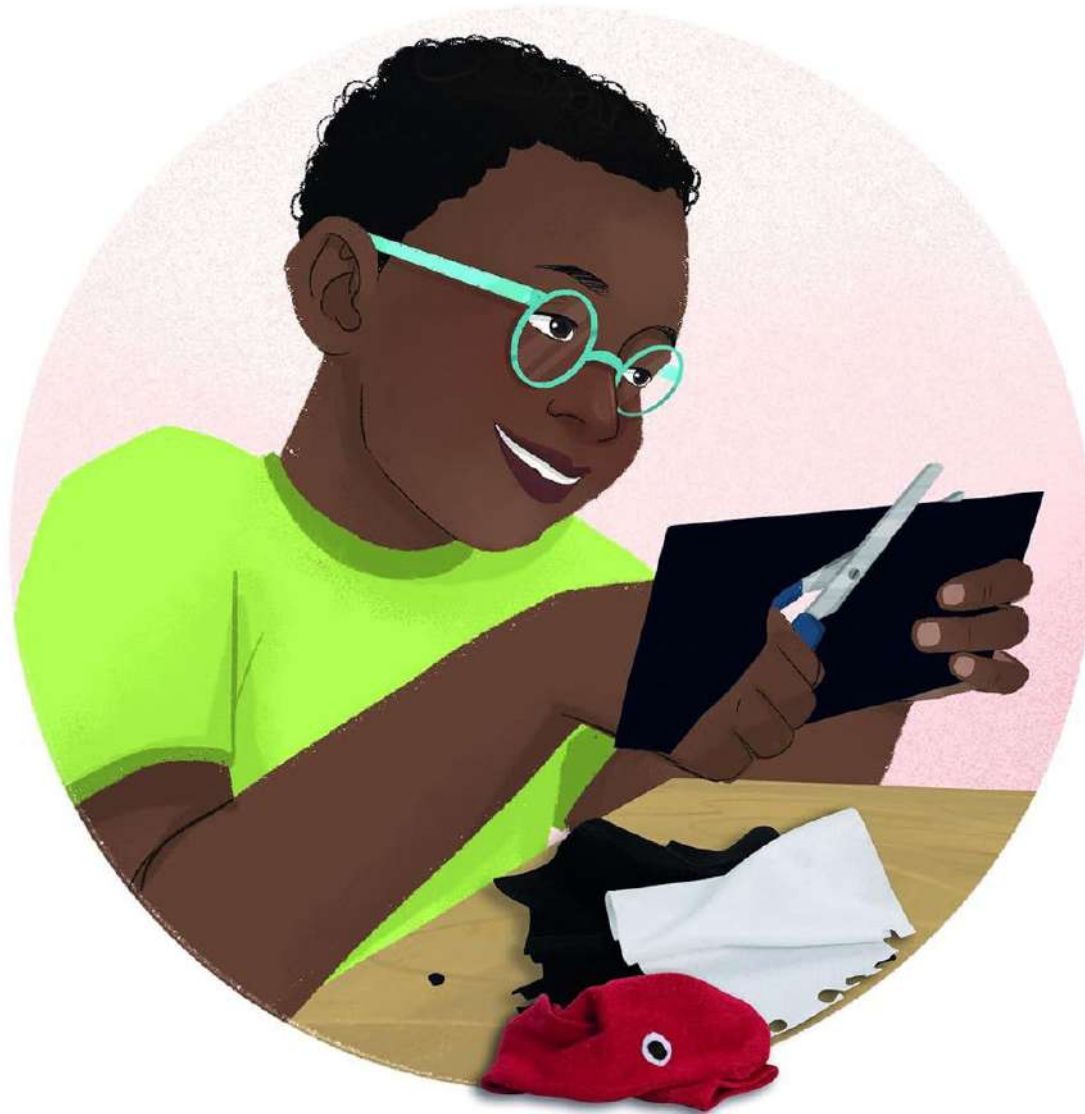
During reading

- If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: s-o-ck, sock.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about the information.

After reading

- Ask your child: *Did you like the sock bug? If you made a sock puppet, would you make a bug or something else?*
