### Help your child to read!

This book practises these letters and letter sounds. Point and say the sounds with your child:

















Your child may need help to read these common tricky words:





#### Before reading

- Look at the cover picture and read the title together. Read the back cover blurb to your child.
- Ask your child: Have you ever been to a pottery painting place? If so, what did you paint? If not, do you think you'd enjoy it?
- · Talk about the image in the magnifying glass.

#### During reading


- If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: d-u-ck, duck.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about the information.

#### After reading

- Talk about the images on page 16. What can your child tell you about them?
- Ask your child: What did the boy paint on the mug? What did he do with the mug at the end? What would you do?
