# Help your child to read!

This book practises these letters and letter sounds.  
Point and say the sounds with your child:

ff

ll

w

x

Your child may need help to read these common tricky words:

the

go

and

is

Before reading

- Look at the cover picture and read the title together. Read the back cover blurb to your child.
- Ask your child: *Would you like to go on a picnic? Where would you have your picnic?*
- Talk about the image in the magnifying glass.

During reading

- If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: f-i-ll, fill.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about the information.

After reading

- Talk about the images on page 16. What can your child tell you about them?
- Ask your child: *What might you take on a picnic? What would be good to take in case it rains?*
- Discuss with your child where you could go for a picnic.
