#### Before reading

- Look at the cover picture and read the title together.
  Read the back cover blurb to your child.
- Ask your child: What do you think this is? Have you seen or read anything about the Moon/space?
- Talk about the image in the magnifying glass.

### During reading

- If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: M-oo-n, Moon.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about the information.

### After reading

- · Talk about the images on page 16. What can your child tell you about them?
- Ask your child: Who went to the Moon? How did they get there?
  What was your favourite page in the book? Why?
- Talk with your child about whether they would like to go to the Moon, and why. Talk about what they think it would be like on the Moon.
