Help your child to read!

Before reading

- Look at the cover picture and read the title together. Read the back cover blurb to your child.
- Ask your child: *What do you do to look after the world around you/the environment?*
- Talk about the image in the magnifying glass.

During reading

- If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: r-u-bb-i-sh, rubbish.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about the information.

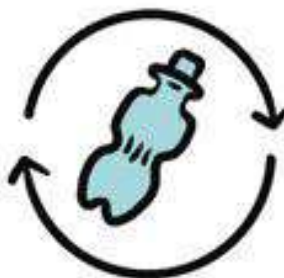
After reading

- Talk about the images on page 16. What can your child tell you about them?
- Ask your child: *How can you use less water? Why should you think carefully before throwing something away?*
- Discuss what you have learned about how you can look after the world around you/the environment. Why is this important? What else could you do?
