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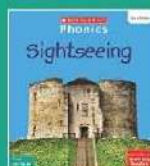

# Help your child to read!

This book practises these letters and letter sounds.

Before reading

- Look at the cover picture and read the title together. Read the back cover blurb to your child.
- Ask your child: *What might you see on a farm?*
- Talk about the image in the magnifying glass.

During reading

- If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: w-i-n-t-er, winter.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about the information.

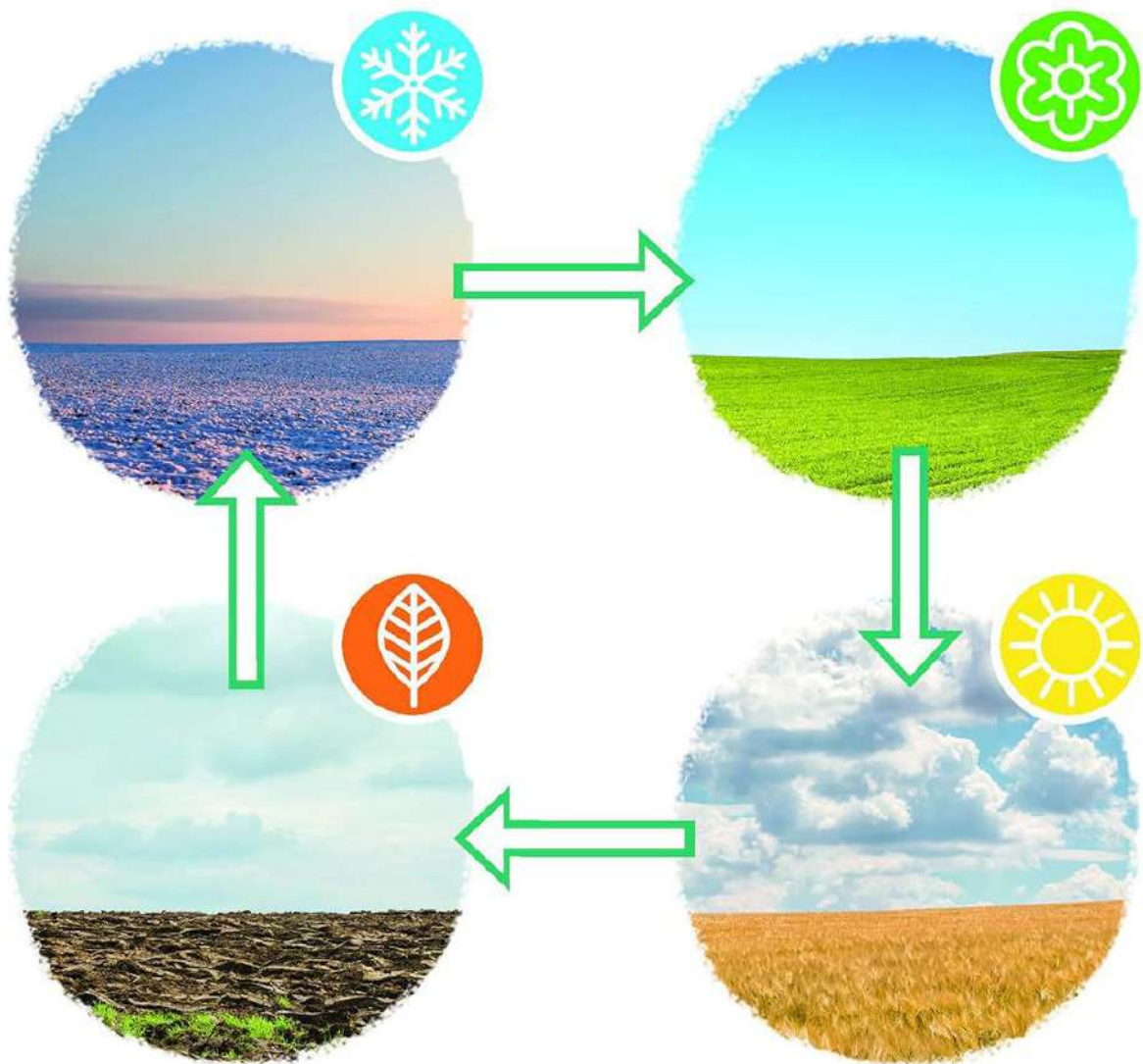
After reading

- Talk about the images on page 16. What can your child tell you about them?
- Ask your child: *How do the cows cool down?*
- Discuss with your child whether they might like to be a farmer. Ask them to explain why, or why not.
