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


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Other titles in Set 6:

Before reading

- Look at the cover picture and read the title together. Read the back cover blurb to your child.
- Ask your child: *What do you like to do at the park?*
- Talk about the image in the magnifying glass.

During reading

- If your child gets stuck on a word, remind them to sound it out and then blend the sounds to read the word: c-oi-l, coil.
- If they are still stuck, show them how to read the word.
- Enjoy looking at the pictures together. Pause to talk about the information.

After reading

- Talk about the images on page 16. What can your child tell you about them?
- Ask your child: *How can you get to the tower?*
- Talk with your child about which play equipment they would most like to play on. Ask them to explain why.
