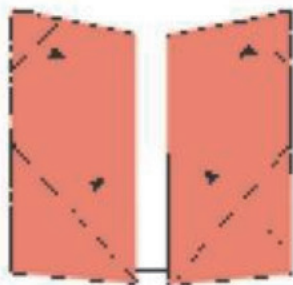
1 Cut a colored paper square in half. Each piece makes a valentine. Write your greeting on the plain side of the paper.



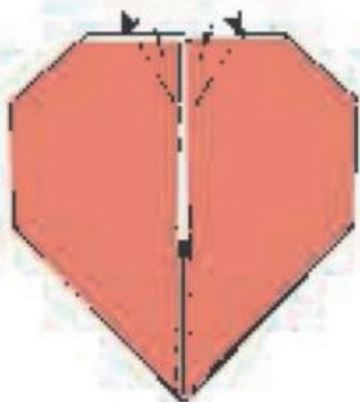
2 Fold in half. Unfold.



3 Fold outer edges to the crease.

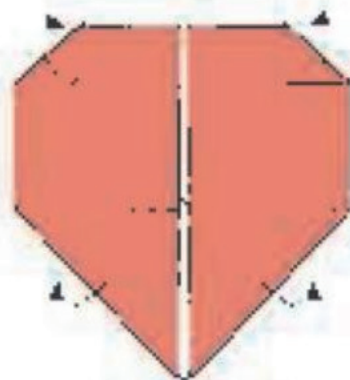


4 Fold the two bottom corners to the middle. Fold the top corners in a little bit.

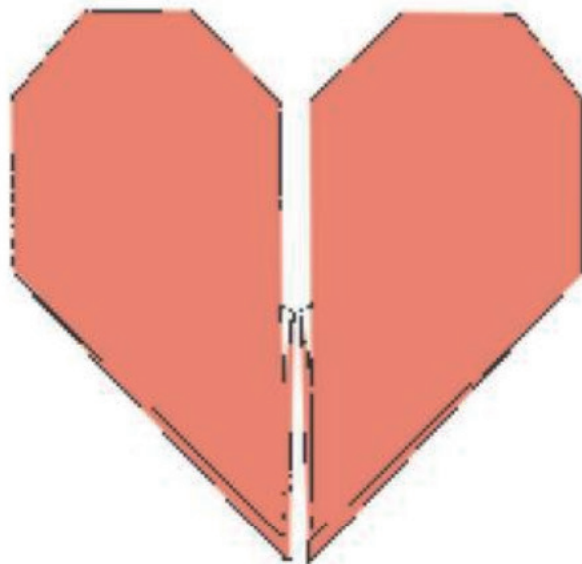


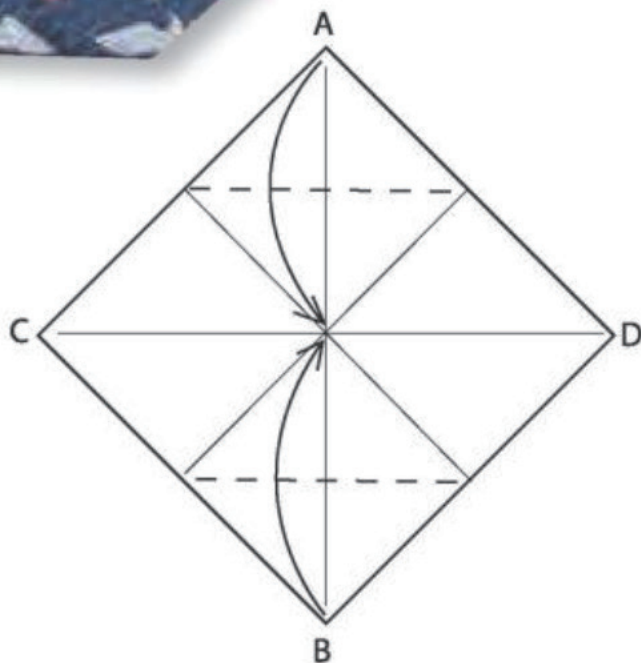
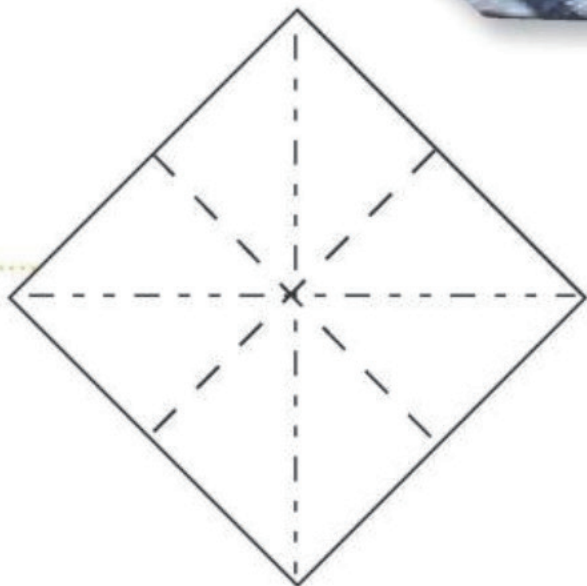
6 Tuck under the two corners in the middle at the top.

Use the Pop-Open Heart as a greeting card at any time of the year or as a valentine in February.



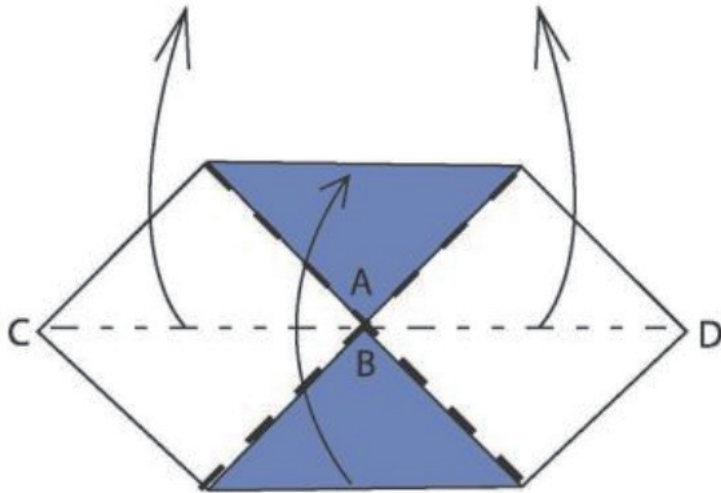
5 Unfold the four corners. Tuck them in between the two main layers of the paper.



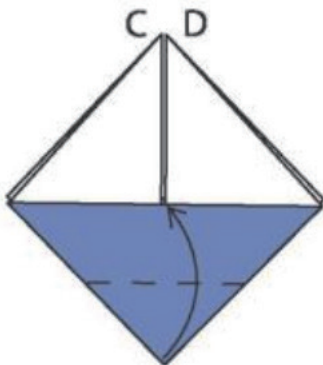


1 Make mountain folds, corner to corner, and valley folds, edge to edge, on the plain side of the paper.

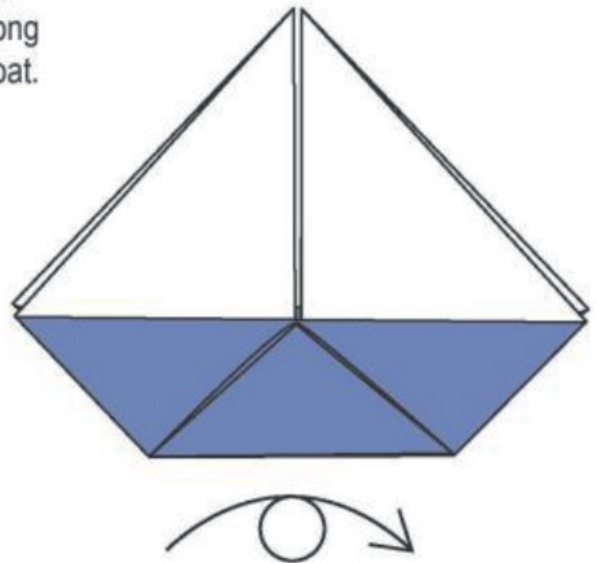
2 Fold the A and B corners to meet at the center of the paper.



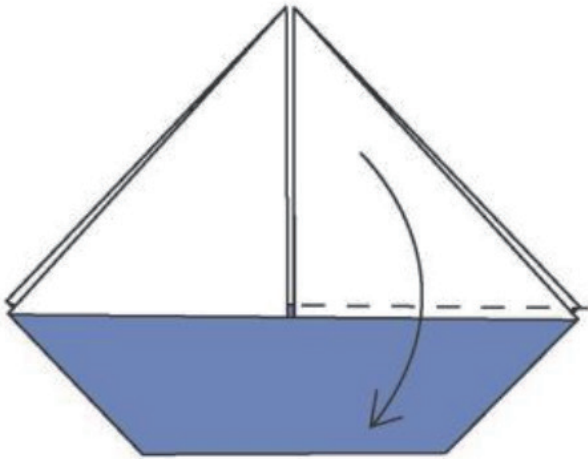
3 Use the mountain fold C and D, bringing them together, to make the sails. Use the valley creases along the A and B corners to flatten the boat.



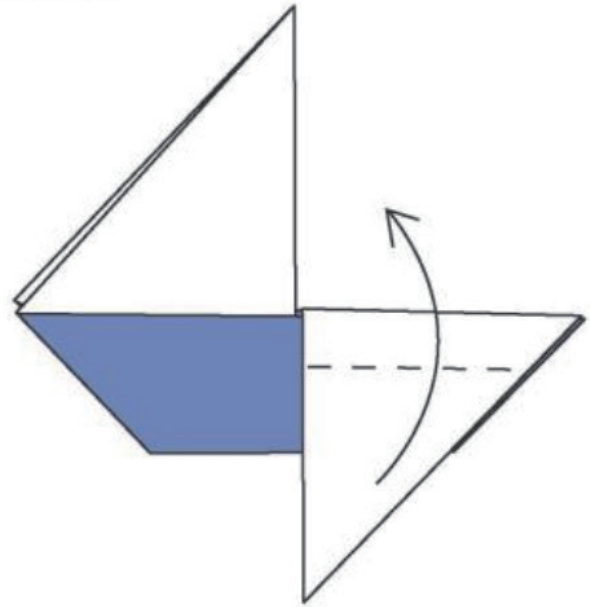
4 Your paper should look like this. Fold up the bottom corner.



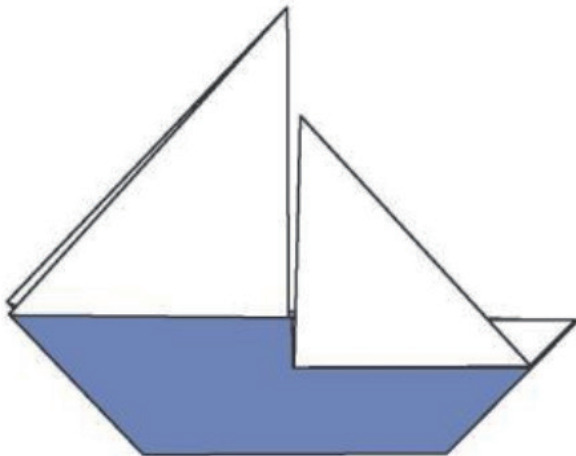
5 Turn over.



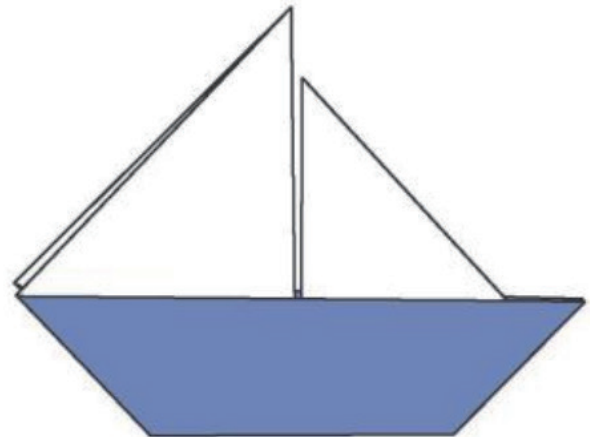
6 Here you have a sailboat. You can make one sail smaller than the other. Fold the sail down.



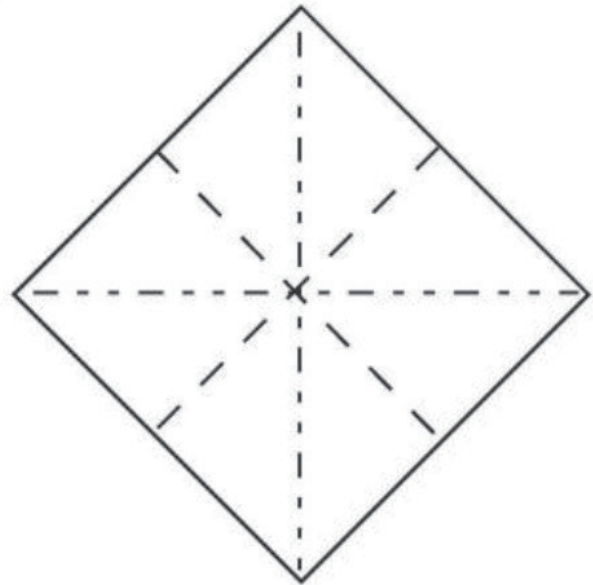
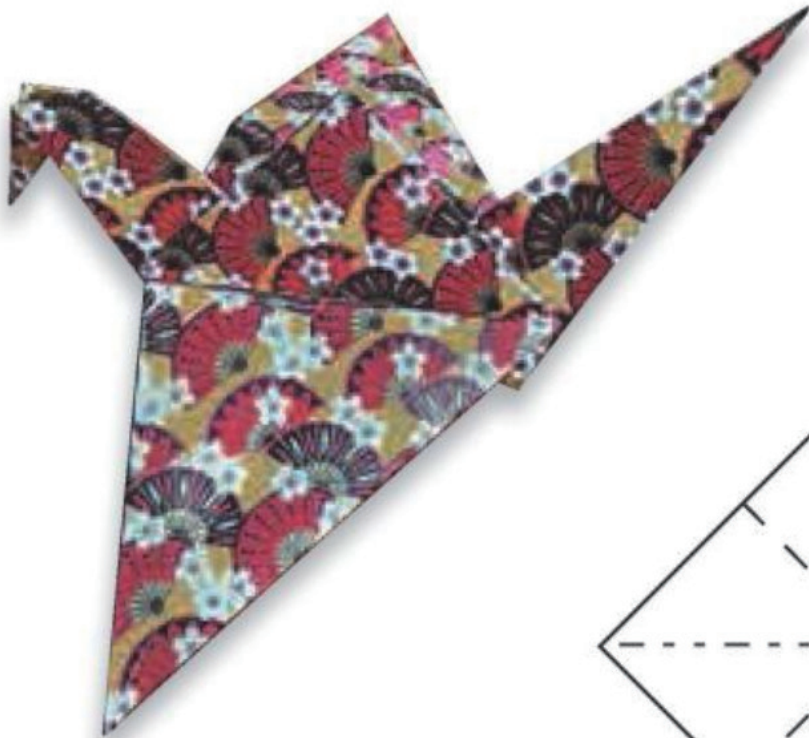
7 Fold some of it back up.



8 Tuck the bottom edge of the folded sail inside the boat.



9 This form of the Sailboat is the logo for OrigamiUSA.

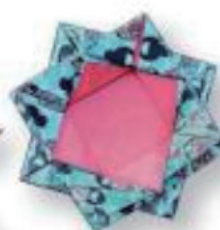
