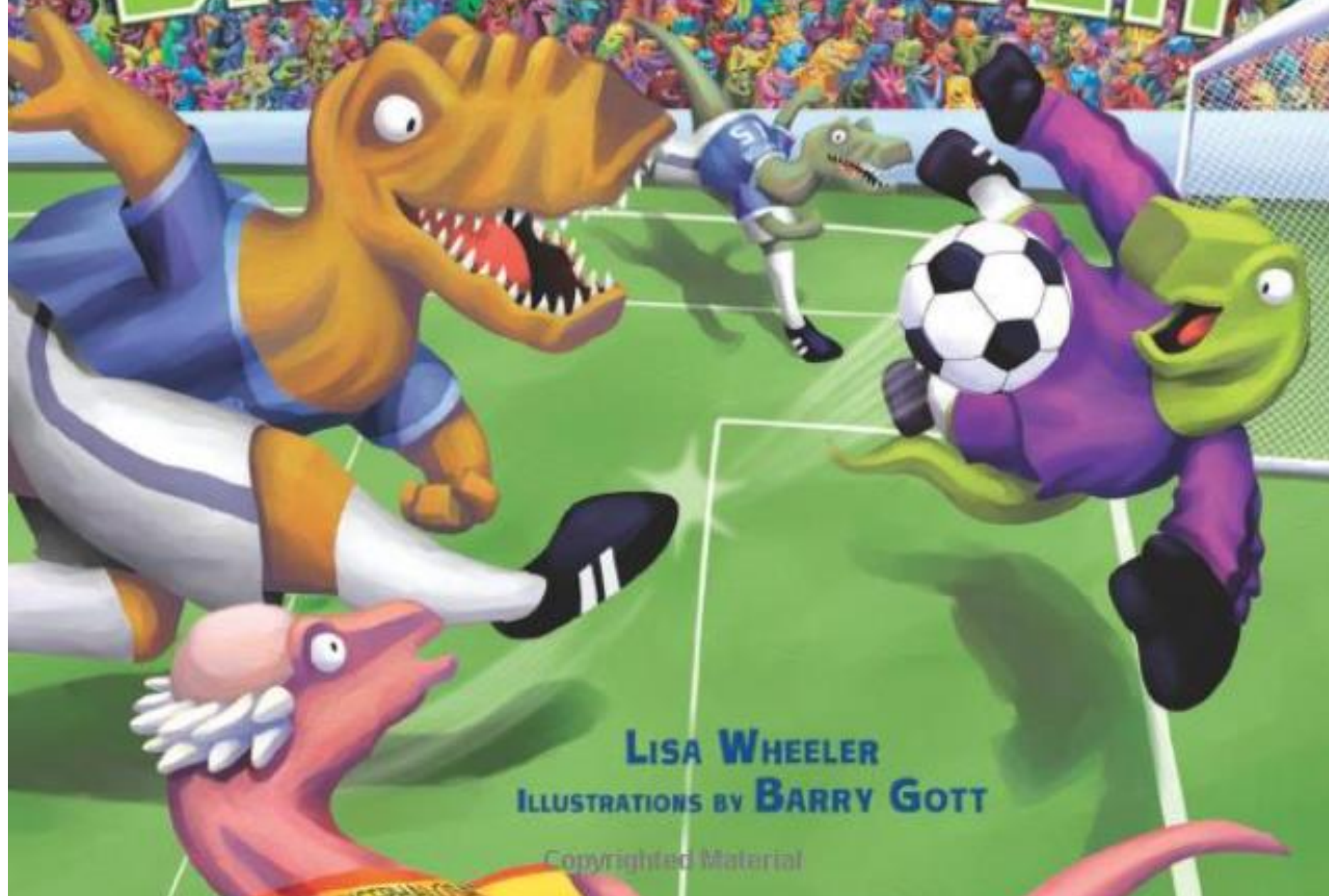

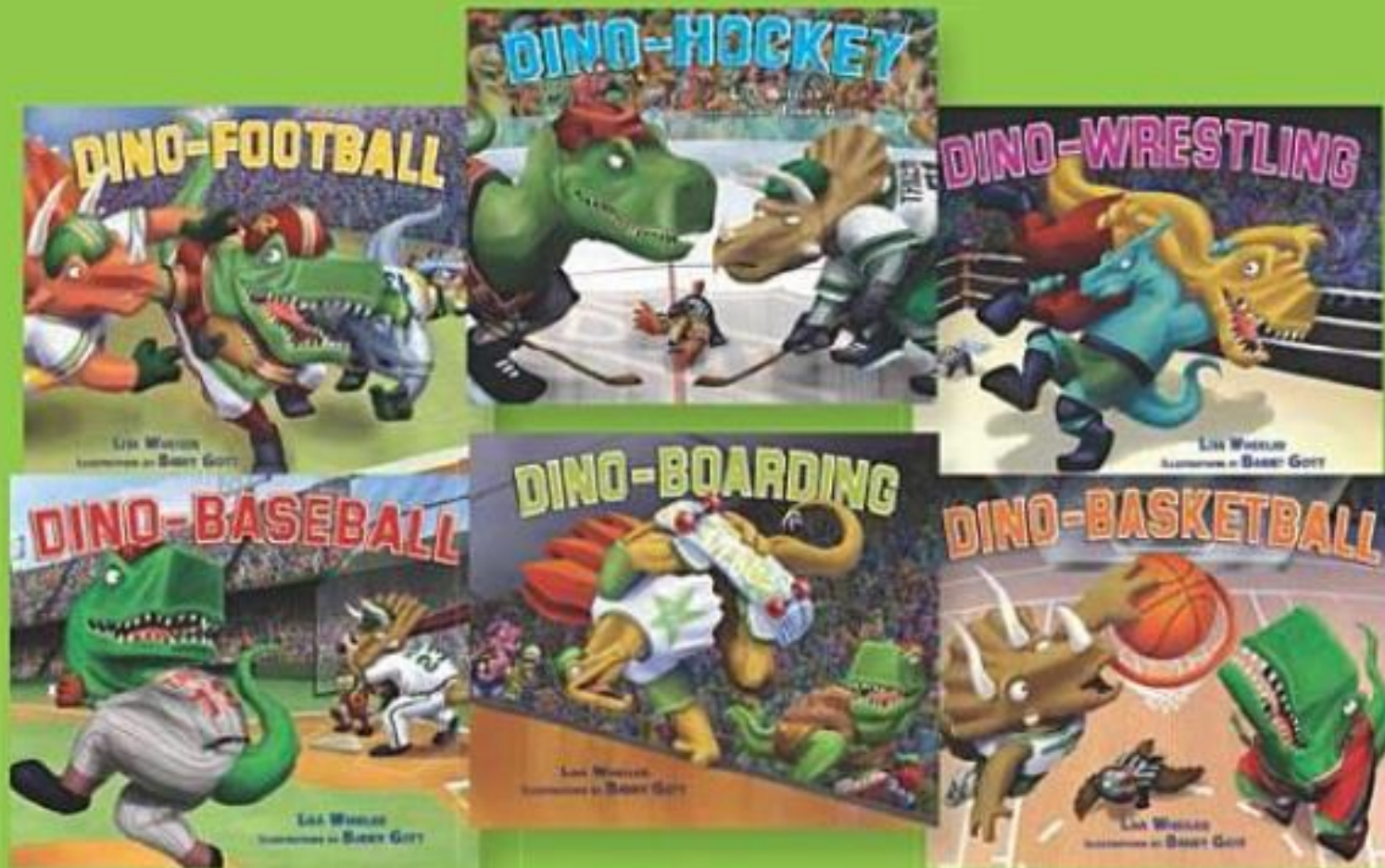

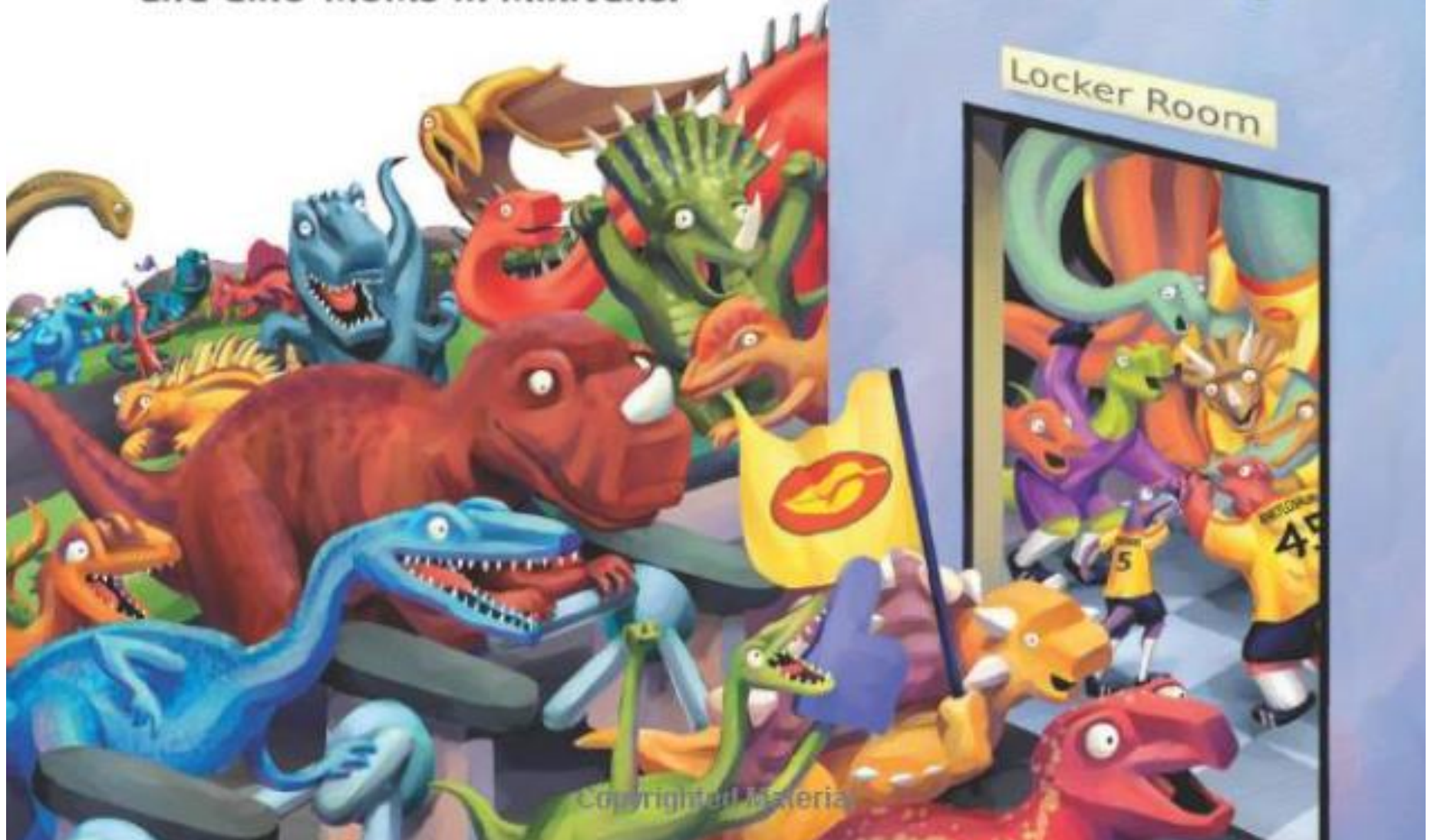

Barry spent much of his childhood playing soccer and also playing with toy dinosaurs, but never at the same time. He is now working to correct that.

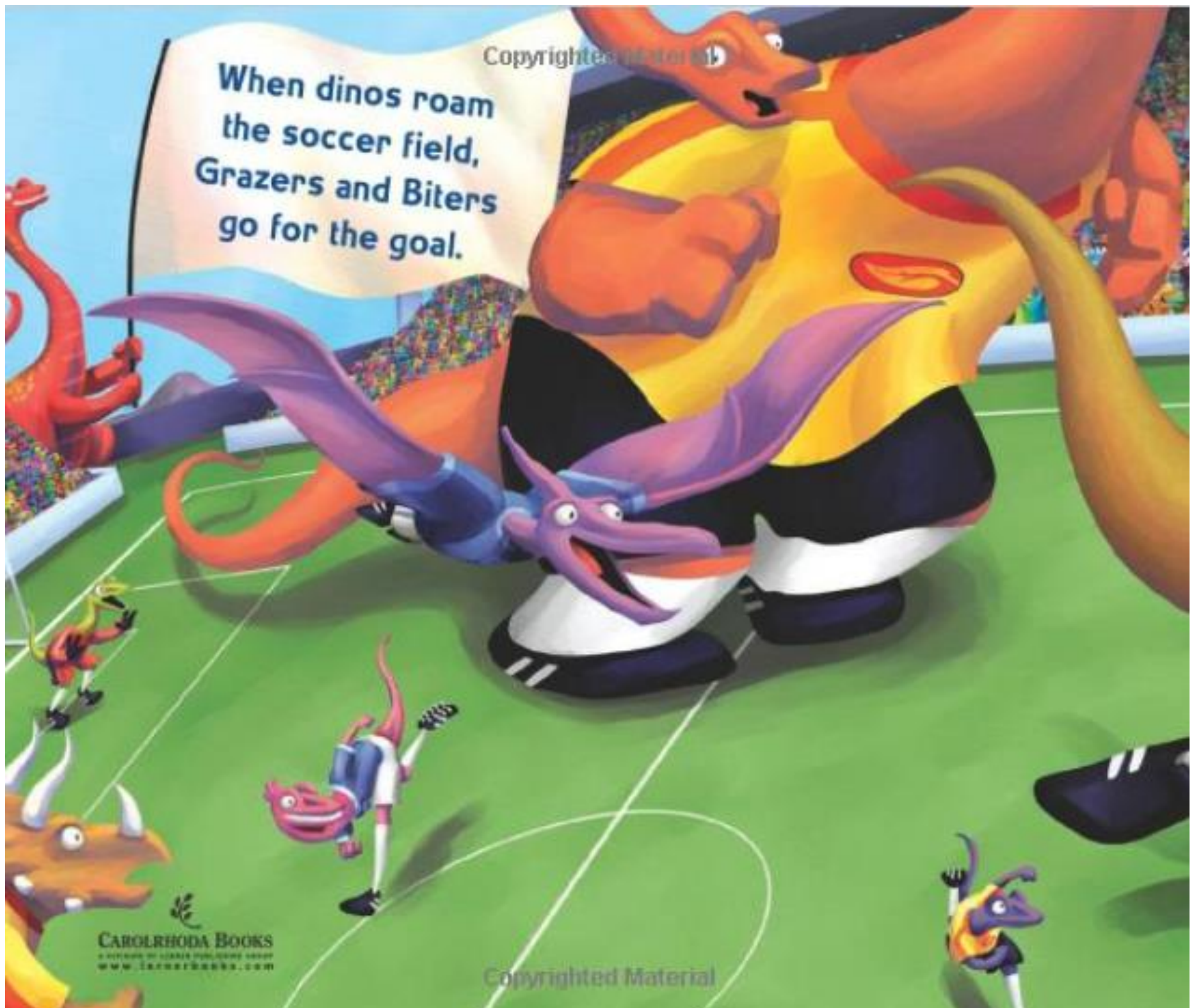
