Then, when Anna and Elsa were teenagers, their parents were lost at sea. The sisters had never felt more alone.

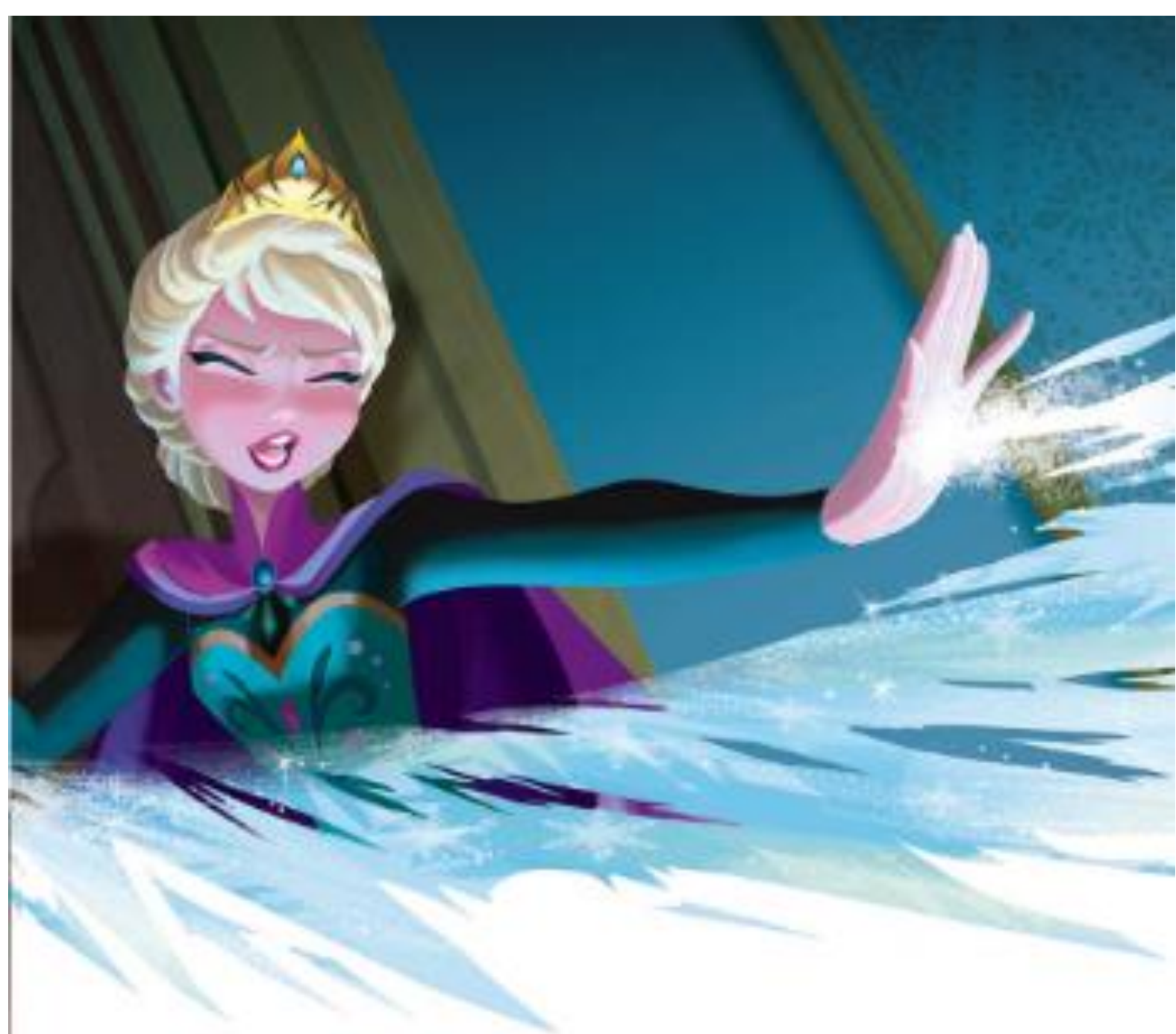


Elsa stayed inside, where she could hide her magic. But she could not keep the castle gates closed forever. On the day of her coronation, her subjects were invited inside to celebrate.
