What does the flag of Mexico look like?

It is green, white, and red. It has an eagle, a snake, and a cactus on it.

What are tortillas made of?

They are made of corn or wheat. Corn tortillas are yellow, but wheat tortillas are white.

How did tacos get their name?

Some people think that the word taco comes from the Nahuatl word tlahco. Tlahco means "half" or "in the middle." Food is put in the middle of a tortilla. So some thing that's how they got their name.





How do you eat tacos?

Just use your hands.



Tamales



What are tamales made with?

They are made with a corn flour called masa.

How do you cook tamales?

Wrap the dough in corn husk or banana leaves and cook the tamales with steam.





When do Mexicans eat tamales?

They eat tamales all year round. They also eat them on holidays. They make hundreds of tamales on holidays.

What are some holidays when Mexicans eat tamales?

Tamales are served on El Día de Candeleria (February 2nd), Day of the Dead (November 1st), Independence Day (September 16th), and the 16 days before Christmas.

What happens on the Day of the Kings on January 6th?

On January 6th, Mexicans eat a cake called king cake. There is a Jesus doll in the cake. If you find the doll in your piece of cake, you must make tamales for your friends on El Día de Candeleria.





Horchata

What is horchata?

Horchata is a drink that Mexicans like.

What are the ingredients for horchata?


It is made from rice, cinnamon, almonds, and sugar.











How is horchata made?

Soak some rice, cinnamon, and almonds in water for four hours. Then put everything in a blender of five minutes. Next, strain it well. It's easy.

You need just a little water to **steam** food.


★ to cook in the hot, wet air that comes up when water gets hot




