Where is Germany?



It is in Europe.

What is Germany famous for?



It is famous for its castles. It has more than 2,100 castles! It is also famous for making cars.



What is the capital city of Germany?



Berlin is the capital of Germany.

Pretzels

How old are pretzels?

The first pretzels were made 1,400 years ago. People made them by hand. A person could make 40 pretzels a minute.



What are pretzels made of?

They are made using a type of dough. The dough is rolled out and twisted into a special shape. Then, salt is put on top of the dough. Finally, the pretzels are baked.

How do people make pretzels now?

Now, pretzels are mostly made by a machine. The machine makes 245 pretzels a minute.



What kinds of pretzels can you buy now?

You can buy many kinds: plain, cheese, and even apple pretzels.



Stollen



What is stollen?

It is a type of fruit bread that Germans eat at Christmas.



Why did the first stollen have no butter in it?

Long ago in Germany, only the king could have butter. But as time went by, ordinary people could have butter, too.



What is stollen made with?

It is made with nuts, spices, dried fruits, and almond paste. It is rolled in melted butter and white powdered sugar.

What does a stollen look like?

A stollen looks like a baby in a blanket.



How big is the giant stollen at the market in Dresden?

It is 1.6 m long and weighs 12 kg. It's very big!



Currywurst



Who created currywurst?

A woman names Herta Heuwer created it. She sold it to workers in the city, then she opened a restaurant.



How much does currywurst cost?

You can buy a currywurst for \$2 or \$3 in Berlin.



How did Herta create the first currywurst?

She was given curry and ketchup by British soldiers. She mixed them together with other spices. This made the unique currywurst sauce. She put the sauce on sausages.

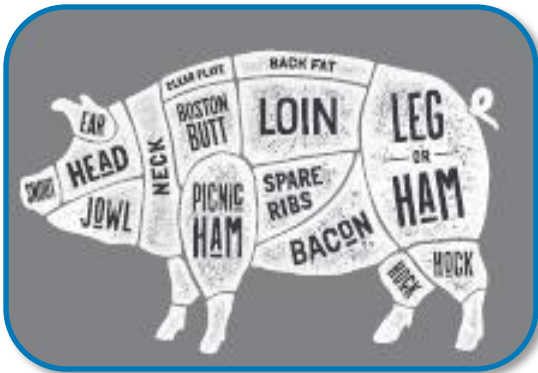

❖ **unique** *adj.*

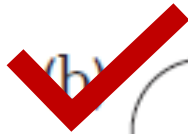
The man likes to have **unique** hair and clothes.

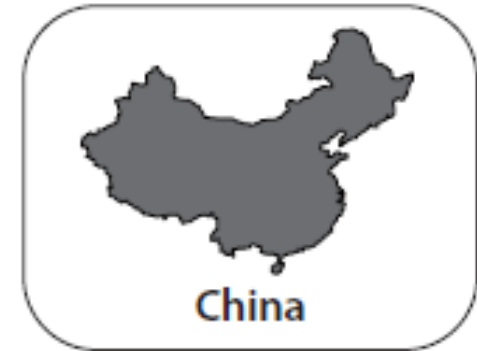
