## A Few of Rome's Most Well-known Sights

### Colosseum

This huge arena was built in the first century AD as a setting for gladiatorial contests. Today, the Colosseum is one of the world's most impressive ruins. There are special exhibits inside.

### Trevi Fountain

Rome's most famous fountain was completed in 1762. The Baroque structure features dramatic sculptures. In the center is the sea god, Neptune. They say throwing a coin into the water guarantees you'll return to Rome. At night, the fountain is beautifully illuminated.

### Mouth of Truth

The "Bocca della Verità" is a large marble disc with an image of a face. It is located at the entrance of the church of Santa Maria in Cosmedin, which was built in the 6th century. A famous story says that the mouth will bite off the hand of a person who tells a lie.
